Perks

- » Annual PLC fish fry and PLC recognition banquets, both hosted by the President of NSU
- » Plan and host a regional high school leadership conference each fall
- » Graduate with distinction and individual recognition at commencement ceremony
- » Graduating NSU PLC seniors travel on an all-expense paid trip



Money Available

Scholarship valued at over \$12,000 per year, including:

- » Up to 18 hours of tuition waivers in the fall and spring and up to 6 hours in the summer (Oklahoma students only; non-Oklahoma PLC students will be charged in-state tuition and receive a waiver to cover their out-of-state tuition)
- » \$1,200 on-campus housing allowance each semester (PLC students must live on-campus for first two years)
- » \$800 stipend each semester
- » Renewable for up to four years with a 3.25 minimum GPA and leadership requirements
- » Total value of over \$49,000



Eligibility

- » Must be a high school senior with a minimum ACT score of 22, minimum unweighted GPA of 3.5
- » Demonstrate proven leadership skills
- » Provide three leadership recommendations (one must be the high school counselor)
- » Finalists will be interviewed by the PLC Advisory Committee and current PLC president
- » 25 graduating high school seniors awarded each year

Perks

- » Honors classes such as literature, university strategies and communication taught by distinguished faculty
- » Annual events, including float trip, banquet, homecoming tailgate and socials
- » Hands-on experience through research in your major
- » Students that complete the program requirements graduate with distinction and individual recognition at the commencement ceremony



Money Available

- » Three tiers of scholarship money available, **starting at \$12,000 per year**
- » All levels include up to 18 hours of tuition waivers in the fall and spring and 6 hours in the summer (Oklahoma students only; non-Oklahoma honors students will be charged in-state tuition and receive a waiver to cover their out-of-state tuition)
- » \$1,500 on-campus housing allowance each semester
- » Receive \$500, \$1,600 and \$1,750 stipend per semester depending upon which specific honors scholarship you receive
- » Renewable for up to four years with a 3.25 minimum GPA and research requirements



Eligibility

- » At least a 3.5 GPA in high school
- » Minimum ACT score of 28
- » Applications will be reviewed by the Honors Advisory Council and Scholarship Committee
